GENERAL RULES

- Electricity is available upon request.
 You may not run power to any booth on your own.
- Cooking is not permitted in booths.
- Alcohol and/or Beer sales or service are not permitted by exhibitors.
- No glassware is permitted. This includes bottles and other glass items.
- Violations will result in suspension of operations without refund.
- This is a "Rain or Shine" event. There are no refunds.

Your participation as an exhibitor implies acceptance of these terms.



INSURANCE



INSURANCE: As a standard requirement of all Pride Festival Exhibitors/Vendors, it is necessary for you to provide proof of general liability coverage from an insurance company in good standing with minimum policy limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. If you do not have this coverage in place, we have made arrangements for all of our Exhibitors to acquire this coverage at significant savings by purchasing as part of a group. Please click the link below, complete a short questionnaire, process your payment online, print your Confirmation of Coverage, and you will obtain this coverage for \$65 plus any applicable state tax.

Proof of alternative coverage, satisfying these minimums, or secured coverage through the link provided above must be in place prior to the Festival. You will not be allowed to participate without proper insurance coverage in place, naming Stonewall Pride, Inc. and the City of Wilton Manors as Additional Insureds. Please email proof of insurance to me.

- The Stonewall Pride Marketplace is composed of large canopies along Wilton Wilton Drive between 20th St and 11th Street, with each canopy section designated by a color — White, Green, Blue, Orange, Red, Purple and Brown, etc.
- Under the canopy are 10 x 10-foot stalls created by 4-foot-high French barricades which defines your vendor area. Your stall will have an 8-foot table and 2 chairs.
- All booth assignments are final. There will be event staff
 wearing branded shirts to assist you with information, but they
 are not permitted to help you with your booth setup or carry
 materials.







GENERAL INFORMATION

- WILTON DRIVE CLOSED: Wilton Drive will be closed at 4 a.m. on Saturday from NE 20th St to Five Points and vehicles will not be allowed in the festival area.
- CHECK-IN TIME: Vendor check-in starts at 12 noon and ends at 2 p.m.
- **DROP-OFF AREA:** As a vendor, you have been assigned a drop-off area near your booth space where you can unload. There is no parking at the drop-off area please unload as quickly as possible and move your vehicle! After parking, you will need to cart your materials to your booth.
- NO EXIT AFTER 2 P.M.: All delivery vehicles must be removed from Wilton Drive by 12 p.m. Any vehicle still in the festival area after 2 p.m. will not be able to leave until Police re-open the road at 4 a.m. Sunday.

CHECK-IN PROCESS

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ❖ Stonewall Pride Parade and Festival Vendor Check-In begins at 12pm, unless there is pre-approval -police inspection at 2:00 p.m.
- ❖ Proceed to your assigned vendor check-in location (see maps next 3 pages) to check-in your business/organization and staff.
- Parking and Unloading
- * Check-in points are for UNLOADING only. We have volunteers available who will monitor your items until you park your vehicle, and if there is enough staff present, can also assist you with moving your items to your assigned canopy.
- * Entry Tickets are required for EACH of your staff/parade participants.

 These tickets can be purchased at: stonewallpride.lgbt (choose "Parade Participant" or "Vendor Admission")
- ❖ If you are both a vendor and in the parade, choose "Parade Participant" which will get you entrance into the festival and access to your vendor booth.



NORTH VENDOR CHECK-IN

- Brown, Yellow, Black Load-In: NE 23rd Drive and NE 11th Ave



- Head south on NE 23rdDr from Dixie Hwy
- > Turn into parking lot
- Check in at booth
- Unload your booth supplies
- > Park your vehicle
- Proceed up NE 11th Ave to entrance gate
- ➤ After check-in proceed to designated booth

CENTRAL VENDOR CHECK-IN

- Brown, Yellow, Black Load-In: Orange, Red, Violet Load-In: NE 23rd Drive and NE 7th Ave




- ➤ Head south on NE 20th Dr from Dixie Hwy
- ➤ Turn north on NE 7th Ave
- Turn left on to NE 23rd Dr
- ➤ Make U-turn
- > Check in at booth
- Unload your booth supplies
- > Park your vehicle
- Proceed up NE 7th Ave to entrance gate
- After check-in proceed to designated booth

- no free parking city lots are \$20
- everyone entering the festival area must have an entrance ticket.

SOUTH VENDOR CHECK-IN

- White, Green, and Blue Load-In: Historic Richardson Park



- ➤ Head north on Wilton Drive
- > Turn left on to NE 20th St
- > Turn right into parking lot
- Check in at booth
- Unload your booth supplies
- > Park your vehicle
- Proceed up Wilton Drive to entrance gate
- ➤ After check-in proceed to designated booth

- no free parking city lots are \$20
- everyone entering the festival area must have an entrance ticket.



• ADMISSION WRIST BANDS: All booth workers will need to have admission wrist bands. Everyone in the Festival area must be registered, therefore all vendors are required to purchase wristbands for all team members working in the booth. Wristbands are \$10 which you can order on the web site (www.stonewallpride.lgbt). The wrist bands will be provided at the entrance gate for each individual.

• **VENDOR PARKING:** There is no reserved parking for vendors this year. Parking spots are available at City lots at 23rd Street, 8th Terrace, Hagen Park, Richardson Park and City Yard on Dixie Hwy. Parking in the City lots is \$20, with no inand-out privileges. Parking without paying or parking in a non-designated are subject to towing.


• MARKETPLACE HOURS: The Stonewall Pride Marketplace opens at 3 p.m. All vendors must keep their booths open until 9 p.m., but you have the option of remaining open until 11 p.m. Note that this year the parade will begin at 7 p.m. and end around 8:30 p.m., so there will be lots of people around and additional interest in the booths after the parade end. All canopies are lighted.



- No vehicles will be allowed back on Wilton Drive until after Police have completed their sweep, which we anticipate will occur at around 12:30 a.m.




2023 STONEWALL BOOTH LAYOUT
