Dear Business owners/staff,

This year's Stonewall Pride will be held on Saturday, June 20th, 2026, from 3pm to 11pm. Wilton Drive will be closed from NE 20th St. through 5-points (Dixie Highway) in Wilton Manors from 4am Saturday until 6am on the next day, Sunday.

Vehicles must be removed from Wilton Drive, side streets and adjacent private property inside the festival area by 4am, Saturday, June 20th to avoid being ticketed and towed.

No vehicle entrance or exit will be allowed on Saturday.

Set-up, Delivery or Food Trucks will be denied entry without permit from Stonewall.

Food Trucks or Vehicles left for festival participation must have a Wheel Clamp.

Food Trucks or Vehicles left for festival participation must have a Stonewall Issued Pass.

Road Close & Access Restrictions start on Wednesday AM and end Sunday morning.

No free walk-on access to Wilton Drive to reach your business on Saturday.

For free staff access, email permit@hotspots.lgbt with your company name, address on Wilton Drive and the number of staff needing access on Saturday to request your free promo ticket (comp) code that will work for the number of tickets you requested. You will provide that comp code to each staff member who will then go online to request their own free access ticket at stonewallpride.lgbt with the comp code you provided them (select STAFF/VENDOR/PARADE Participant Ticket). Without tickets in advance, each person will have to pay to walk onto Wilton Drive to reach your business. **You must email No Later than June 12th if you want to use the free comp code. After that date, regular ticket prices will apply to everyone without exception (online tickets \$15 and at the door \$18).**

AFTER using your comp code to redeem your free admission ticket, you can show your ticket at the festival entrance to receive your the Staff/Vendor Parade Participant wristband or you can "check-in" in advance at Sterling Accounting (Hotspots Office) with your ticket to receive your wristband(s) so you have them on you for Saturday's event. This can be done during the hours of 10am to 6pm Monday through Friday from June 2nd to June 9th. After the 9th, wristbands can no longer be redeemed at Sterling Accounting so any person with a comped ticket will have to use their zero-purchase receipt ticket in the line with everyone else at the festival entrance to get their wristband.

Very limited vehicle access Saturday morning will be available by Stonewall Pride permit issued to allow set up crews or food trucks onto the drive to reach your business. ALL VEHICLE ACCESS STOPS AT NOON AND ALL ABILITY TO LEAVE VIA VEHICLE ENDS AT NOON - per Police Order. Any vehicle left will be towed at owner expense or immobilized by Stonewall Pride until the event is over and police give the all clear. Permits can be requested by emailing permit@stonewallpride.lgbt with your company name, address, type of vehicle and reason for the waiver permit NO LATER than Monday, June 9th. Please note that permits are not guaranteed even though requested.

On the day of the event, there will be a \$25.00 flat rate (all day) to park in any of the City Official parking lots. **NO CASH - Credit Card Only.** It is your responsibility to make payment at the meter or with staff and place that payment receipt in your windshield facing out. However, employee discounted parking permits for \$12.50 may be purchased in advance for City Parking (valid only in the official parking lots listed below). To purchase a discounted employee parking permit, please stop by the Park Wilton Manors office at 517 NE 21st Court, Wilton Manors (located in the Gables Wilton Park building), Monday-Friday 10am-5pm. Please present a valid employee ID or employment letter. Employee discount permits must be obtained by 5pm, the Thursday prior to Stonewall. When parking in one of our official parking lots, permits **MUST BE** displayed face up on your dashboard to avoid receiving a citation. **Please Note: Parking is first come, first serve and there is no guarantee of available parking spaces even with a permit.**

- Municipal Complex—2100 N Dixie Hwy (Close 5am Sunday) *DOES NOT OPEN till Monday 7am for access to vehicles.
- 23 @ 23 - 1008 Northeast 23rd Dr

The link with the Road Close and Access Map stated previously shows how Wilton Drive, side streets and business lots are affected with closures that start Wednesday morning and increase each day with Saturday 4am being fully closed. On Friday several other spots along the drive and/or side streets are closed. This may restrict public access to a couple business parking lots.

The Shoppes of Wilton will have limited employee parking (but absolutely no customer parking) with access by **permit only** with entry NO LATER than noon and autos may not leave till police give the all-clear for vehicle exit which will be between 11:30pm Saturday and 12:30am Sunday morning. Shoppes' business owners/managers contact permit@stonewallpride.lgbt for your restricted parking passes for staff no later than Monday June 9th and provide company name, address on Wilton Drive and number of passes. Passes will be provided to the business who then are responsible to provide them to their staff.

Please let your staff know that if they decide not to take advantage of parking in one of the official lots, we strongly discourage them from parking in any unauthorized or non-designated area. Illegally parked vehicles will be ticketed and/or towed during Stonewall weekend at the owner's expense.

Individuals with handicap parking placards are required to pay for parking in any of the official parking lots.

NEW CITY POLICY: All private property and public streets within the confines of the Stonewall Pride festival are banned from having any vehicle in their area after 4am Saturday morning. It is the property owner or participant permit holder responsibility to have their lots emptied by 4am. Stonewall Pride is required to tow any vehicles left on aforementioned properties. If vehicles are left, the property will not be allowed to be within the confines of the festival, please see your signed agreement terms in your permit from the City.

NEW CITY POLICY: Any vehicle left within the confines of the Stonewall Pride festival after 4am Saturday, the day of the event, must have prior permission to be in the festival grounds by Stonewall Pride. The permit **MUST** be **VISIBLE** in the Front Window to avoid towing. **Any vehicle that is staying to be part of the festival must have permission from Stonewall Pride in advance** with a pass issued and a **wheel clamp lock visibly and correctly placed** on the front tire. You must obtain your own wheel clamp before you are allowed in the confines of the festival.
